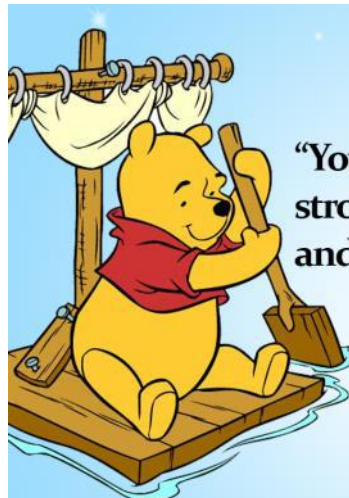

He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it is written, 'The Spirit of the LORD is upon me, because he has chosen me to bring good news to the poor.' (verses 16-18a)

Read [Luke 4:14-30](#)

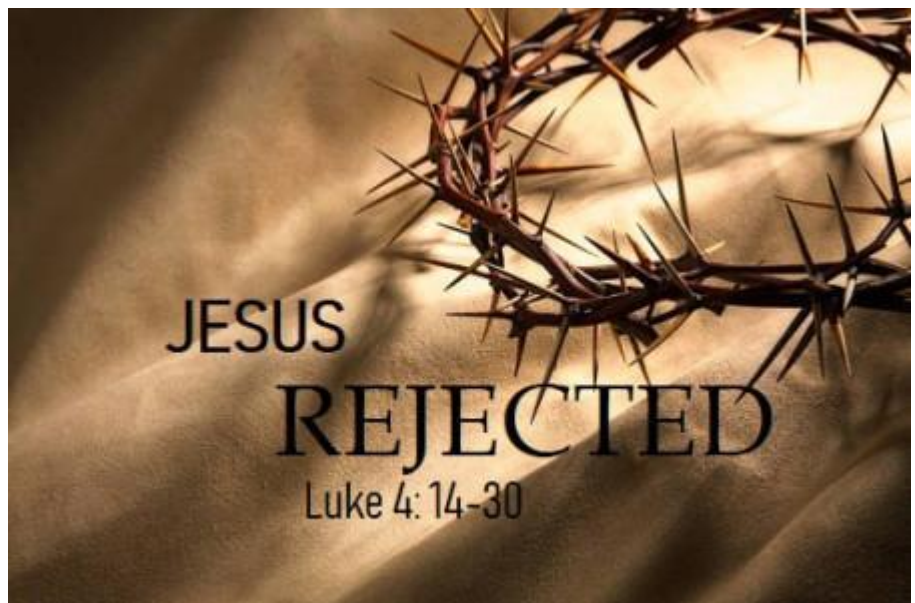

When Jesus reads from the Scriptures and preaches in the synagogue in Nazareth, he makes an exciting announcement: 'This passage of scripture has come true today'. Isaiah had spoken about someone chosen by God to be the people's saviour, healer, and deliverer. Jesus says, 'These words are about me. I'm the one that God has chosen. I'm the one he has sent to bring you good news.'
